At last the long awaited winter rains have started and the vineyards can eventually start shedding their leaves and cuddle up for a nice and lengthy, well deserved rest.

What has been a very up & down harvest and a strange start to autumn, with cooler temperatures and windy conditions during February and March and rain in April, the pattern seems to be normalising and hopefully this is the start to a traditional cold and wet winter. The cover crop that we sowed in-between the vineyard rows are slowly sticking out their necks above ground and a beautiful green sheen is covering the vineyards.

The 2013 Chenin Blanc and Sauvignon Blanc wines are being bottled at the moment and will be ready for enjoyment soon – watch out for these lovely exuberant fresh & fruity wines.



AWARD WINNING WINES

Rhebokskloof 2010 Black Marble Hill recently won a gold medal and Rhebokskloof 2010 Estate Shiraz won a silver award at the Syrah du Monde awards 2013. This is the third award for the Rhebokskloof 2010 Black Marble Hill in one year as it was also selected as one of the Top 100 SA Wines in 2013 and won a Michelangelo Gold award in 2012.



DID YOU KNOW?

CORK SPOILAGE OF WINES

A mouldy flavour can develop when a combination of lignin (wood component), halogen (chlorine, bromide or iodine) and certain micro-organisms are together under suitable conditions. The mouldy character of a corky wine is associated with TCA (trichloro-anisole). Corks are made from the bark of the cork oak tree, which contains a large microflora population. Traditionally the raw cork bark was treated with boiling water to remove undesirable components and a chlorine solution to bleach the cork. Consequently the combination of lignin, halogen (chlorine) and micro-organisms existed, which made corks prone to mouldiness. Cork suppliers had to adjust their production methods to minimise this risk.

The estate offers a variety of venues, including a Bedouin tent under permanent roof structure that hosts a maximum of 300 guests. The Cape Dutch venue is perfect for smaller celebrations with a maximum of 100 guests.

Wedding ceremonies can be held in the lush gardens. A beautiful boma is also an option for a unique braai experience with breathtaking views.
