Welcome to Wal du Charron, our 45 Ha farm in the historic Boulei vallez!

The farm was initially proclaimed in 1699. In 2006 it was christened Wal du Charron by its current owners as a tribute to valley's rich background:

Nal du Charron means "Vallez, of the Wagonmakers" and was the original name of the Wellington vallez. The French influence sterns from the Auguenots who settled in the area in the early, 1700's while the wagonmaking refers to the fact that Wellington was the last town where the prioneers could replenish their or wagons before heading over the majestic Bainskloof in to the then unknown hinterland.

In 2012, Val der Charron itself became an Estate i.e. all wines under the Val der Charron labels are bottled, produced and come from vines grown on the farm itself; thus giving a pure expression of the terroir to be found on its south facing slopes.

Val der Charron is not only one of the most beautiful farms in the valley, but it also has huge natural potential - fantastic as pect, continental climate like Dao, Rioja and the Rhone, rich red soils and a whole bouquet of varietats, 16 to be exact, from Merlot to Eouriga Nacional, from thirty, year old Chenin blanc to Pinot Gris, Cabernet Sauvignon to Malbec. Why, so many different cultivars?

Val du Charron strongle, believes in blending! Ehere different varietals have different, get verz, unique qualities and if put together, produces a composition which is more complex, richer, finer, more finessed and more unique than any cultivar on its own.

Eo quote Fabrice Langlois, winemaker of Chateau Beaucastet: "It blend is much like an orchestra where you have all the various sections ... the crisp woodwinds, the solid brass instruments, the rhythenic percussion and the elegant strings ... on their own they, are instruments, but together under the hand of the conductor, a symphony."

RESERVE COLLECTION

250 ml 750 ml Carafe **Bottle** Syrah (Shiraz) 297 Dark crimson with a deep red core, a lively wine with velvety and rich textures and a slight dry smokey finish. Racy and refined with red fruits, sweet spice and peppery nuances. The fruit intensity and silky tannins fill all the holes on the palate. Cabernet Sauvignon 85 221 Distinct berry richness complimented by cassis, cedar, spicy oak, leather and dark chocolate mint aromas. Youthful earthy flavours are rich, delicious and appealing, with a harmonious balance; fairly soft tannins and a long finish. Merlot 85 221 Aromas are black cherries, cherry pit and raspberry, with hints of nutmeg and tobacco, evolving in the glass to nuances of chocolate and mocha. Medium bodied and elegant with velvety tannins on the palate. 221 Intense dark purple with black cherry and eucalyptus to the fore, with elements of fresh mint, fynbos and a touch of sandal wood. The palate shows freshness and youth with juicy fruit, good structure and soft, well integrated tannins. 129 Chardonnay 50 Bright straw hue, intense lemon nose, with apple, cashew, earthy, flinty, and buttery aromas with underlying grapefruit and oak flavours. Velvety body, with a crisp and lingering finish. Round and creamy mouthfeel. 129 **Pinot Gris** 50 Brilliant green straw hue, intense grapefruit nose,
