

## ENVIRONMENTAL AWARENESS

Viticulturist Simon Grier has always been a keen supporter of maintaining environmentally friendly vineyard practices. The farm has made **no use of insecticides** during the past 14 years and a flock up to 1 000 Peking ducks are responsible for natural pest control. There is a strong focus on water conservation and recycling and a greening project, which involved the planting of over 1000 000 indigenous trees on the farm. Villiera started using Solar Power in 2010. Power consumption has been reduced by 44 % in 5 years.

Steenbok, Porcupine Cape Fox, Bat-Eared Fox, Grey Mongoose, Water Mongoose, Guinea Fowl, Pheasant, Blue Crane, Caracal etc. survive in the vineyards. We have 35 owl boxes in the vineyards, some containing barn owls, many with crows, Egyptian geese and swarms of bees.

Our philosophy has led to a **vibrant eco-system** on the farm that has born fruit with Villiera being accepted as **suppliers to Marks and Spencer in the UK and Woolworths in South Africa.** In 2010 Villiera received the Marks and Spencer award for sustainable farming.



## T W O H O U R G A M E D R I V E A N D B I R D I N G

In conjunction with our neighbours (The Cape Garden **Centre & Wild Clover Farm**) we have set aside 220ha as the Villiera Wildlife Sanctuary. A game drive lasts approximately 2 hours. Visitors are guaranteed fantastic sightings of a diverse population of antelope, for example Gemsbok, Giraffe, Burchell's Zebra, Eland, Springbok, Bontebok, Black Wildebeest, Kudu as well as other small mammals and a huge diversity of birdlife attracted by the 12 dams and marsh areas. On a clear day one has a beautiful panoramic view of the mountains overlooking the Cape Peninsula. The cost of a game drive is **R260.00pp** (valid until 31 January 2021). 
