It was tough, but our "one in a million" production team pulled it off. We harvested 1569.06 tons from 7 am till 9 pm on the 5th of February 2020. (We've never received that much for one day!) So, we don't want to brag, but it's a job well done and definitely a milestone! Without hard work and great determination, we would have not been able to set a harvest-record.
